### Present simple

Facts	House prices <b>increase</b> every year. The journey <b>takes</b> seven hours.	
Timetables and Programmes	My flight <b>leaves</b> at 6.30 tomorrow morning. What time <b>does</b> the concert <b>start</b> ?

We use the continuous tenses with action verbs.

We do not usually use them with **state verbs** (want, believe, know, taste, prefer, understand, belong, like, suppose, agree, etc). For **state verbs** we use the simple tenses.

USE	<u>EXAMPLES</u>
Activities happening now	He's having lunch at the moment. Where is the manager? She's speaking to a customer.
Temporary situations and activities	Which hotel are they <b>staying</b> at? He' <b>s working</b> in London next week.
Present trends	People <b>are living</b> longer.  Jeans <b>are selling</b> well this year.
Fixed future arrangements	We're <b>leaving</b> at 11 a.m. on Thursday. What time <b>are you going</b> to the party tonight?
